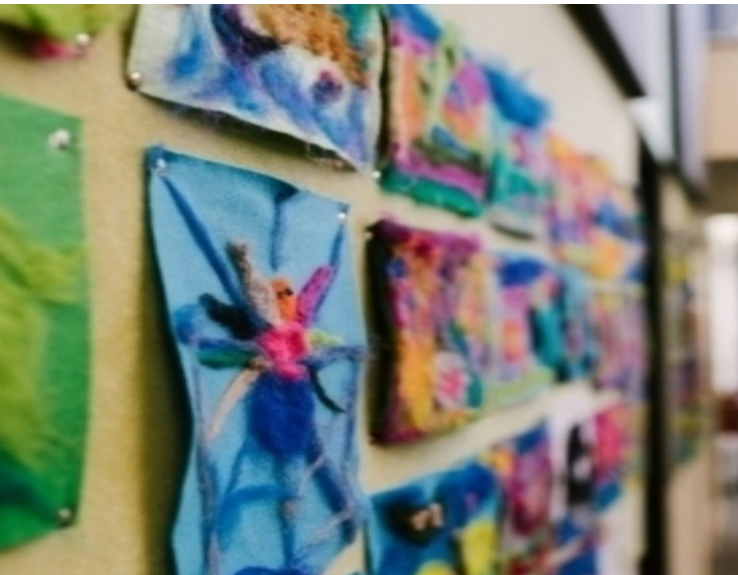

HIPY gives you access to activities for you and your child – you'll gain new skills, confidence and connect with parents. It provides you with the tools to give your child a strong start in education.

OUR PROGRAM

Join HIPY with your 3 year old child and each fortnight, HIPY Tutors will bring you storybooks and activity packs and practice them with you so that you feel confident doing them with your child.

Each activity helps your child learn through play and supports their development in five different learning areas. HIPY only takes 10-15 minutes a day of learning and playing with your child to make change that lasts a lifetime.

HIPPY GATHERINGS

Gatherings are fun, welcoming and family-friendly. They're opportunity for you to meet other HIPY families, learn about your child's development and to hear about local services and events in your community.

HIPPY TUTORS

Tutors are HIPY parents trained in each of the HIPY activities and will practice them with you at each home visit. As HIPY parents, Tutors have the personal experience and community knowledge to support you as you learn with your child.
